The following crimes were reported in Mt. Airy from October 4 to October 10, 2008.

### THEFT FROM AUTO, ATTEMPTED AUTO THEFT

October 4: 6400 block Ardleigh St. &ndash; Passenger's side window of vehicle broken. Taken were registration and insurance cards.

October 4: 6400 block Ross St. &ndash; Complainant returned to find that entry to his 2005 Volkswagen Passat had been gained. Taken were CDs and change.
