The following crimes were reported in Mt. Airy from December 20 to December 26, 2008.

THEFT FROM AUTO, ATTEMPTED AUTO THEFT

December 20: 100 block West Upsal St. – driver's side window of Honda Accord broken. Taken was Tom Tom GPS.

December 20: Unit block East Cliveden St. – Front passenger's side window of Honda SUV broken. Taken were Tom Tom GPS, sneakers, Samsonite luggage, and class ring.
