The following crimes were reported in Mt. Airy from January 2 to January 8, 2009.

THEFT FROM AUTO, ATTEMPTED AUTO THEFT

January 5: 300 block West Hottter St. - Rear driver's side window of 2004 Ford Explorer broken. Taken were Christmas presents, and box of cigars.

January 5: 200 block West Duval St. - Rear driver's side window of 2001 Nissan Xterra broken. Two pair of sneakers taken.
