The following crimes were reported in Mt. Airy from September 13-19, 2008

THEFT FROM AUTO, ATTEMPTED AUTO THEFT

September 13, 1000 block Washington Lane – Vehicle broken into from rear passenger window, keys stolen from ignition.

September 14, 6600 block Boyer St. – Driver side turn signal removed from vehicle.

September 18, 6600 block Ross St. – License plate taken off of 1993 Toyota Camry.

STOLEN AUTO

September 19, 6700 block Bass St. – Police responded to call, found complainant suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to chest and lower torso, complainant pronounced dead at hospital.
